2014 Pinot Noir Willamette Valley

This is a blend of Pinot Noir from Stormy Morning Vineyard in Banks and our estate vineyard.

Winemaking Notes

The grapes were harvested by hand and destemmed to 1.5 ton vats. After a 4-day cold soak, fermentation began. The must was pumped over and punched down twice daily and pressed when dry. The wine settled overnight, then was racked to 25% new French oak barrels to age until bottling the following September.

Tasting Notes

Aromas of allspice, cola, cherry, raspberry, cranberry, Marionberry, and rose petals. On the palate, this wine is dry and light-bodied with lively acidity and structure. Flavors include red currants, cherries, cranberries, black tea, and forest floor. There's a strong midpalate presence, and a very long finish.
